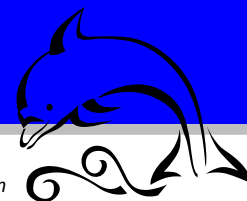

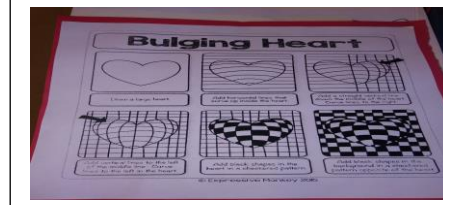
Parent-Teacher Organization
