By the end of the 2021/2022 school year I will participate in tiered coaching cycles for at least 3 hours with all content teachers that are identified on my caseload who need support in their classrooms through PDs or observation cycles. Teachers will be tiered based on prior evaluation scores, DOJ necessary hours, administration collaboration, and varying classroom support needs. There are 36 teachers total that I will be coaching throughout this year, 23 of which will be literacy and MLL specific coaching cycles, the remaining 13 will be literacy focused.

Due to the fact that we do not currently have a Math coach this is rigorous and attainable because there is a high need for instructional support for our teachers this objective will help prioritize their needs.
