INTEGRATED PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Serving students **aged 3-5**, Integrated Pre-K is a lottery based pre-kindergarten program that is open to students of all needs. It is an integrated classroom where students needing specialized services learn and grow alongside their peers. Dual Certified teachers follow the Creative Curriculum and schedule.

Available programs:

FREE!

- 4-year-olds Half day programs (AM or PM) -Monday through Friday; or full day programs, Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday
- 3-year-olds Half day (AM or PM) Monday through Friday or full day programs, Thursday and Friday

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES?

- Your child must be three years old by September 1st of the current school year.
- Your child must have completed the Child Outreach Screening prior to application.

HOW DOES THE LOTTERY WORK?

 Applicants are selected via a random drawing of names.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

 Transportation is available for students living greater than one mile from school.

WHAT IS A CHILD OUTREACH SCREENING?

- It is a free program that provides information about your child's development in the areas of vision, hearing, speech/language, general development and social emotional development.
- Screenings are recommended every year for all three, four, and five-year-old children.

RI PRE-KINDERGARTEN

RI PRE-KINDERGARTEN (RI Pre-K) serves students who are four years old by September 1st. The full day program is a lottery-based, free, high-quality program funded and overseen by the Rhode Island Department of Education.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES?

• Your child must be four years old by September 1st of the current school year.
